

May OPL Board of Trustees' Meeting Minutes

1. CALL TO ORDER

The Omaha Public Library Board of Trustees met on Wednesday, May 21, 2025 at the W. Clarke Swanson Branch, 9101 W Dodge Rd. Vice President Reddick called the meeting to order at 5:22 pm
